



## Period: 40,000-10,000 BC **Upper Palaeolithic Age** marks the appearance of new flint industries. **Significance** modern human beings (Homo sapiens) first appeared in the upper Palaeolithic ag Bimbhetka(MP) **Earliest rock cut paintings Andhra Pradesh** Karnataka Sites Maharashtra **Chotanagpur Plateau Upper Palaeolithic Age** Gujarat **Less humid** belongs to end period of Ice age Climate Climate became comparatively warm Increase in flora and Fauna Parallel-sided blades from a prepared core **Blades** blade tools are comparatively large A chiseled stone with a sharp point **Burins** Used for engraving on rocks and bones Tools flint implement with a sharpened edge Scrapers used for scraping material such as hide or wood. Leather, wood, and bone were also used Bones were also used to make needles, fishing tools, harpoons, blades and burin tools
