


Educational Qualification

The candidate must have at least a bachelor's degree from a recognised university to take the UPSC exam.

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Even those candidates who have written the final year exams of the qualifying exam (bachelor's degree) and are awaiting results can apply. Also, candidates who would write the final exam are also eligible to apply for the IAS prelims exam. But, these candidates must produce proof of passing the exam while applying for the IAS mains exam.

Exam Pattern

The first stage of the exam i.e., the Civil Services Preliminary Exam is only a screening test and is conducted to shortlist candidates for the Main Examination. Marks secured in Preliminary Exam are not taken into account while preparing the final merit. Preliminary Exam consists of two papers of objective type carrying a maximum of 400 marks.


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For Efficient & Effective Study of Prelims Exam

- ⇒ Read standard book from Cover to Cover.
- \Rightarrow Don't make notes in the first reading itself.
- Keep your booklist short and simple. Better to read one book for each topic thoroughly, than flip through multiple sources.
- \Rightarrow Read carefully and between the lines since Prelims questions can be tricky.
- Preliminary Exam is all about 'identifying' the correct answer among the 4 options given.
 It's all about elimination of the wrong options and identifying the correct one. Focus should be more on understanding the concepts



➡ The maximum marks for an IAS Interview is 275. Although it may seem less than the Mains, achieving a high score here can lead to securing one's desired service or cadre.

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- ➡ This would include the Psychometric Test as well as Personal Interview.
- The objective of the interview is to assess the personal suitability of the candidate for a career in public service by a Board of competent and unbiased observers. The candidate will be asked questions on matters of general interest.
- \Rightarrow The test is intended to judge the mental caliber of a candidate.
- In broad terms, this is an assessment of not only the candidate's intellectual qualities but also his social traits and his interest in current affairs.







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

Vacancy Trend of UPSC CSE



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




