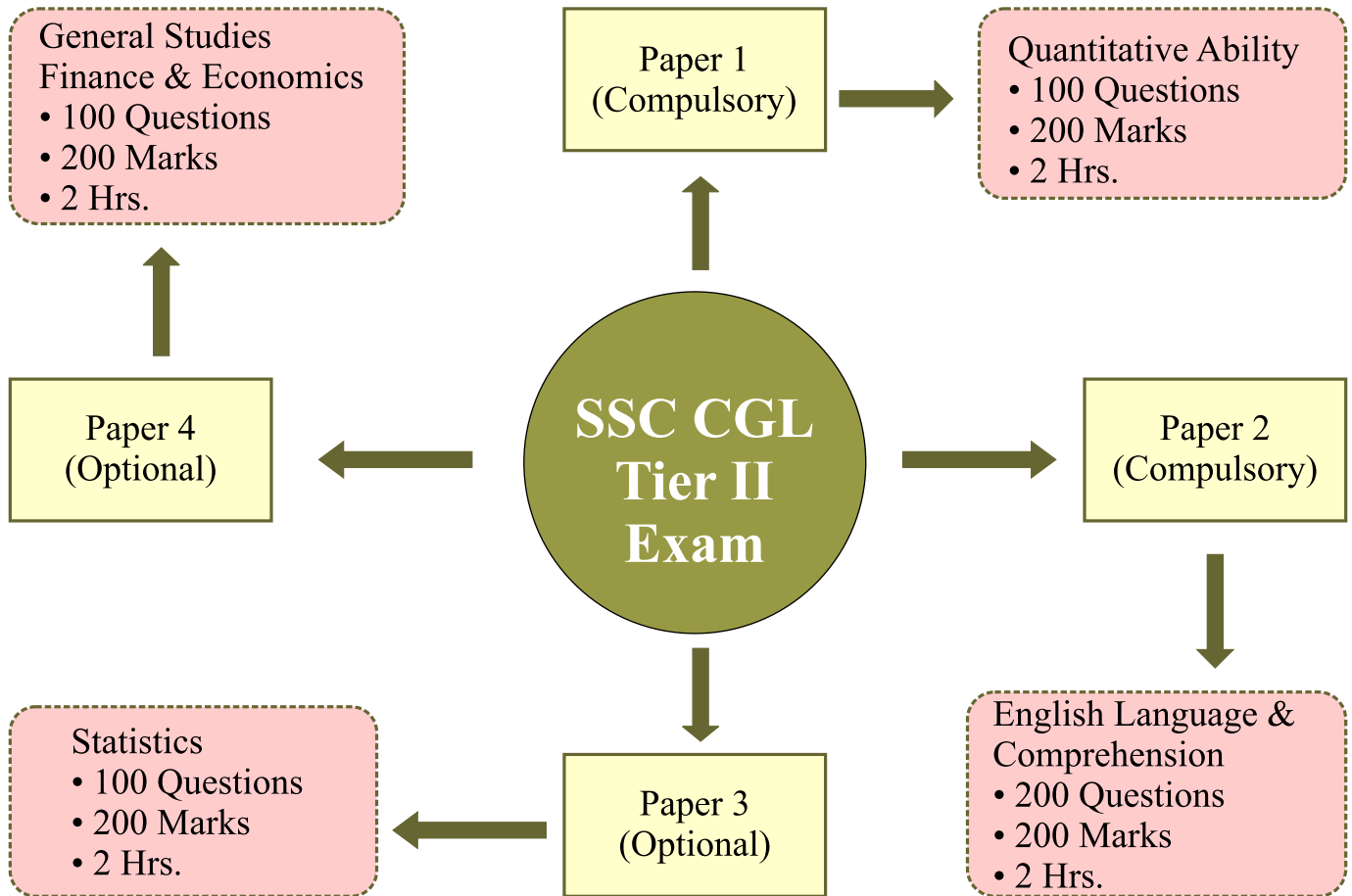

Tier 2 Exam Pattern

SSC CGL Tier-2 exam will be conducted online comprising of 4 papers with There are 2 compulsory papers- Paper 1 and Paper 2. Paper 3 and Paper 4 are opted by candidates choosing the specific post of Assistant Audit Officer and Junior Statistical Officer.



In Tier 2, there will be a negative marking of 0.25 for each wrong answer in Paper-II (English Language and Comprehension) and of 0.50 marks for each wrong answer in Paper-I, Paper-III and Paper-IV.

Tier 3 Exam Pattern

Tier-3 of SSC CGL will be a descriptive test. The paper will be in English/Hindi and will constitute of 100 marks. The entire paper needs to be completed in 60 minutes.

Tier 4 Exam Pattern

SSC CGL Tier-4 Exam is a Computer Skill Test. It will be conducted in two steps: DEST Test & CPT Test.

- **DEST**: Candidates are required to type 2000 words in 15 minutes on a computer in English. This test is conducted to check a candidate's writing skills.
- **CPT**: This test is conducted to check a candidate's proficiency in Word Processing, Spreadsheets and Generation of Slides.

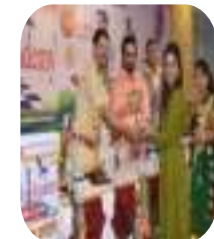

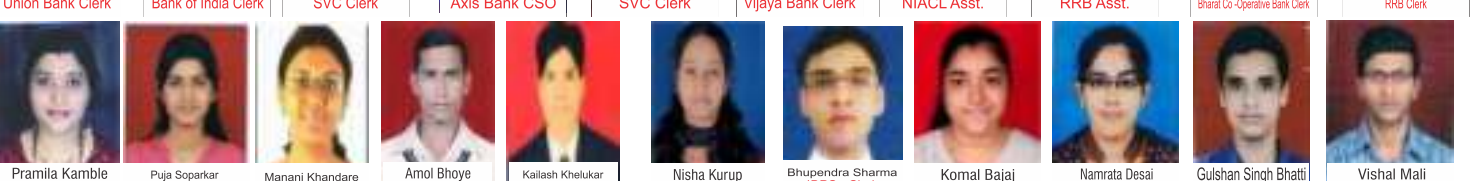
